Ultrasound

Ultrasound is a noninvasive imaging test that shows structures inside your body using high-intensity sound waves.

Doctors use ultrasound exams for several purposes, including during pregnancy and for diagnosing medical conditions.

Some of the most common ultrasound are: Prenatal, abdominal, renal, pelvic and transvaginal.

Some ultrasound require patients to make some preparations such as fasting or drinking water.

At NMP we provide our patients with the best ultrasound technology, including 4D ultrasound imaging.

X-ray

Another imaging test is the X-ray. Unlike ultrasounds, it uses radiation to create black-and-white images of the inside of your body.

X-rays are most commonly used to look at bones and joints, but providers can use them to quickly diagnose other conditions.

Some X-rays require patients to make some preparations such as fasting or taking a creatinine lab test.

Mammogram

Mammograms are an essential breast cancer screening and diagnostic tool. Using low-dose X-rays, they can show abnormal areas in your breast tissue.

It can help detect changes that could lead to breast cancer before you have symptoms. Most females should begin getting mammograms at age 40, although your age and frequency depends on your risk.

When taking a mammogram don't use deodorant, powder or lotion around the armpit or chest area.

CT Scan

A CT scan (computed tomography) is an imaging test that helps doctors detect diseases and injuries. It uses a series of X-rays and a computer to create detailed images of your bones and soft tissues.

A CT Scan can detect:

- **Certain types of cancer and benign tumors.**
- **Fractures**
- **Heart disease.**
- **Blood clots.**
- **Brain injuries.**
- **Spinal cord injuries.**
- **Internal bleeding**

A CT scan is painless and noninvasive. All contrast CT Scans require patients to take a creatinine lab test to check kidney function.
